Weight is key. A lighter yacht is faster and more responsive, while allowing capacity for cruising equipment without compromise. Combined with carefully considered cockpit layouts, every Arcona is designed to be confidently sailed short-handed in any conditions.

All Arcona models are modern boats, with efficient sail plans - tall, powerful and easily managed - unmistakably Arcona at sea.

THE ARCONA 415

The Arcona 415 continues the Arcona tradition with confidence and clarity. Her modern hull shape and elegant lines deliver impressive pace and reassuring control, remaining composed and responsive even when conditions become demanding. Powerful yet easy to manage, she offers a sailing experience that feels both refined and assured.

On deck, the layout is designed for control and comfort. Twin wheels, an open transom and a spacious cockpit provide excellent visibility and secure handling, while all sheets and control lines are led within easy reach. Whether sailed shorthanded or with a full crew, the Arcona 415 is intuitive, balanced and rewarding at the helm.

The Arcona 415 builds on the success of the Arcona 410, a model renowned as a true performance cruiser with exceptional

attention to detail. Increased light below deck and improved stowage enhance everyday life on board, while preserving the focused sailing character that defines the Arcona range.

Below deck, Scandinavian craftsmanship shapes a bright and welcoming interior. Clean lines, generous light and well-considered spaces create comfort for family and crew, equally suited to extended cruising or life between races.

Built using advanced materials and vacuum infusion, the hull features a 20 mm Divinycell foam core, with all bulkheads fully bonded for strength. At the heart of the yacht lies Arcona's galvanised steel cradle, absorbing the loads of rig, mast and keel, delivering the stiffness, balance and sailing feel that define the Arcona experience.

EXTERIOR DESIGN

With an open transom as standard, the Arcona 415 offers easy access when moored stern-to or boarding from a dinghy, while also enhancing safety at sea. The self-draining transom performs confidently in heavy seas and provides excellent access to the aft lazarette, making the stowage space both practical and secure.

The exterior styling is clean and contemporary. The coach roof features a single, uninterrupted recessed glass window that follows the roofline, while larger, rectangular hull windows replace the previous elliptical design. Together, they bring increased natural light below deck and give the yacht a modern, purposeful expression.

On deck, everything is designed to work in harmony. Wide side decks, a balanced keel and rudder, and a well-considered deck layout make the Arcona 415 easy to handle under sail. Control lines are efficiently arranged, allowing the yacht to be sailed confidently shorthanded, while the spacious cockpit comfortably accommodates the full crew in harbour.

Built using advanced materials and vacuum infusion, the hull features a 20 mm Divinycell foam core, with all bulkheads fully bonded to the hull and deck for added strength. At the heart of the yacht lies Arcona's galvanised steel cradle, absorbing the dynamic loads from rig, mast and keel, delivering the stiffness, balance and sailing feel that define the Arcona experience.

INTERIOR DESIGN

The Arcona 415 is available in either a three-cabin or two-cabin layout, with the option of one or two heads to suit a range of preferences. Below deck, Scandinavian craftsmanship defines the interior: warm, beautifully handcrafted joinery in rich Khaya mahogany creates a timeless expression of quality and detail. For those who prefer a lighter aesthetic, light oak is offered as an elegant alternative, bringing a bright and contemporary feel to the interior.

The hull and coach roof windows are large and thoughtfully positioned, allowing generous natural light to fill the interior. This enhances both the mood and sense of space in the saloon and cabins, making the living areas feel open and welcoming even at anchor or on passage. Practical touches such as cabin reading lights with integrated USB ports add everyday convenience, allowing phones, tablets and other devices to be charged where they are used.

The saloon itself is spacious and well-proportioned, with comfortable seating and views that extend through the enlarged windows. Adjacent, the classic Arcona galley is exceptionally well equipped for life at sea, with thoughtful storage solutions, generous work surfaces and easy access to all cooking and service areas, making meal preparation straightforward whether underway or in harbour.

Every berth on board is designed for comfort, with full-length and generous width ensuring restful sleep after a long day at sea. In the forepeak, the wide berth allows you to sleep with your head forward without compromise, a detail that makes extended cruises more comfortable for crew and guests alike.

Access to essential systems is straightforward: the engine is easily reached through a dedicated service hatch, and tankage is readily accessible, supporting practical maintenance and peace of mind on longer passages.

Bright, functional and intelligently detailed throughout, the Arcona 415 interior balances performance-minded design with genuine liveaboard comfort. It is a space you will appreciate more deeply with each year of ownership, welcoming, capable and crafted to make every moment on board a pleasure.

SWEDISH CRAFTSMANSHIP BUILT FOR PERFORMANCE

THE ARCONA STORY

Arcona’s roots lie in Swedish boatbuilding, beginning as a small family yard in the Stockholm archipelago in the late 1960s. From the very beginning, Arcona has been about more than building yachts, it has been about sharing a way of sailing. Owners, sailors and builders have always been closely connected, united by a belief in performance, balance and long-term quality.

That philosophy took form in 1982 with the Arcona 32, defining the Arcona approach: a racer’s heart paired with a cruiser’s comfort. A long-standing collaboration with designer Stefan Qviberg shaped the brand’s distinctive balance and sailing feel, supported by Arcona’s signature galvanised steel frame, known for its strength, stiffness and confidence under sail.

Through the 2000s, models such as the Arcona 400 established the modern Arcona look, while advanced construction methods reduced weight and increased strength. International recognition followed, including European Yacht of the Year for the Arcona 430 in 2009, an achievement shared not only by the yard, but by the growing community of Arcona owners sailing their yachts across the world.

Since 2018, Arcona has been part of Najad Group, alongside Najad, while retaining its clear focus on performance-driven design. This continued evolution has led to further accolades, including European Yacht of the Year for both the Arcona 435 and the Arcona 50, the latter marking Arcona’s entry into the super-premium segment.

Today, choosing an Arcona is not simply about owning a yacht. It is about becoming part of a long-standing family of sailors, people who value craftsmanship, sailing performance and the quiet confidence that comes from a boat built by those who truly sail themselves





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
